



Damage Waiver - A Moving Company

(scheduler4amovingcompanyllc@gmail.com) This is required of all customer utilizing A Moving Company Services.

- Furniture pads & Wrapping furniture and other items: The customer is responsible for furniture pads when loading. One dozen pads per 5 feet of space is recommended, Unless the customer will utilize equipment that A Moving Company provides. (IF NO BLANKETS ARE PROVIDED THEN ALL DAMAGES CLAIMS WILL BE VOID AND DENIED.)
- Appliances & Electronics: A Moving Company will not be held liable for the results of disconnecting or connecting any appliances or electronic devices. TV's must be in a TV Box. If not boxed Claims are void.
- Movers reserve the right to waive responsibility for an item(s) they feel cannot be moved safely without damage to the home, item, or themselves. If the customer insists or permits the item be moved, A Moving Company will not be held responsible for any resulting damage. This includes but is not limited to models, glass art and any items they deem "fragile". If items are insisted on being moved against Lead mover's recommendations, said item will be noted AGAINST MOVER'S RECOMMENDATIONS and VOID of CLAIM FOR DAMAGES)
- Customer packed boxes and loads without the correct quantity of pads are exempt from our liability. Damaged items deemed valid will not exceed the released valuation of .60/lb. per item. Liability does not include matching set or pairs. Total liability shall not exceed 1/3 of the job invoice amount.
- ABF, 28' Trailer Loads, PODS: These suspensions are spring ride and provide little protection from shifting. Your items will likely be damaged without significant padding and straps. (Press Board, Particle Board items such as Sewing tables, Bookcases and tables to name a few) are not guaranteed for safe transport AND NO REPLACEMENT WILL BE GIVEN. A Moving Company will NOT accept damage claims for ABF, PODS or any other transport that is NOT transported by A Moving Company.
- If a customer or anyone not employed by A Moving Company helps move any items or is in the moving area (equipment, outside the equipment or in the direct contact area), they release A Moving Company LLC. of any liability if damage occurs. A Moving Company will not be responsible for damage caused by non-employees.
- Fragile and special care items must be boxed, and or crate as needed and prepped properly including proper labeling. A Moving Company is not responsible for road vibrations, trailer/truck vibration or acts of God: weather, etc.
- Customer will be held responsible for fiber board, pressboard, IKEA or plywood type of furniture due to the durability of these items. This includes but is not limited to IKEA, Sewing Tables of any kind, and bookcase. Lead Mover can also determine "at Risk" items.
- Items packed by Movers are NOT guaranteed against damage, items inside boxes are packed at the owner's risk. ***MODEL PLANES, GLASS ART AND FRAGILE ITEMS ARE NOT GUARANTEED.
- I understand that once the movers leave the job site and monies are exchanged, the liability for damage claim ends. You or your transportation company takes possession of all belongings.
- Movers have the right to terminate a move if they feel that a house is not ready to be moved at the scheduled time. If The House is Not in sanitary condition or Bio Hazard conditions.

- Guns are NOT to be handled, moved or Transported by Movers. All Gun safes are to be emptied prior to being moved. This is also subject to verification of lead mover if asked. If refused to verify then the movers have the right to refuse to move safe.
- Fire Arms and AMMO will not be loaded and or Transported in Box Truck either provided by A Moving Company or Customer.
- A MOVING COMPANY is not responsible for damaged items from improper loading of a truck, POD, ABF Trailer, U-haul, Penske if Loaded by Customer or different Moving Company. This includes incidental damages that may occur during unloads because items were not properly packaged for moving.
- MOTORCYCLES can be loaded by A Moving Company Movers but A Moving Company is NOT responsible for any damages to motorcycles that may occur. Incidental or other damages during transport.
- Items A Moving Company will not load, include but Not limited to (A Moving Company reserves the right to not load any item they see as dangerous or hazardous):

Prohibited Items

- Batteries, alkaline and lead-acid (automobile)
 - Household cleaning products.
 - Corrosive chemicals or poisons.
 - Lawn and garden chemicals.
 - Flammables and explosives.
 - Live animals or plants.
 - Gas and oil products.
 - Compressed gas cylinders.
 - Propane Canisters
 - Sterno Products or Fluids
 - Lighter fluid, Butaine
 - Any thing not listed but deemed not Safe by A Moving Company Lead will not be loaded by a moving company.
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
